


Literacy Achieves was founded in 1997 as the flagship mission of Preston Hollow Presbyterian Church. Originally established as Vickery Meadow Learning Center, our initial mission was to help adults learn English in nearby Vickery Meadow — a neighborhood with thousands of immigrants and refugees. Today, Literacy Achieves serves approximately 1,100 adult students and 330 young children annually at campus locations in Vickery Meadow, West Dallas and East Dallas. 
