The Stewpot offers a safe haven for homeless and at-risk individuals of Dallas. The Stewpot provides casework assistance and enrichment programs to individuals and families experiencing homelessness, as well as Children & Youth and Family Stabilization programs to at-risk children and their families. Since May 2008, the Stewpot has been the sole meal provider at The Bridge Homeless Recovery Center, serving 1,000 meals per day, 7 days per week. Literacy Achieves was founded in 1997 as the flagship mission of Preston Hollow Presbyterian Church. Originally established as Vickery Meadow Learning Center, our initial mission was to help adults learn English in nearby Vickery Meadow – a neighborhood with thousands of immigrants and refugees. Today, Literacy Achieves serves approximately 1,100 adult students and 330 young children annually at campus locations in Vickery Meadow, West Dallas and East Dallas.
