

Preston Hollow Presbyterian Church Youth Internship Application

Program Definition: The College Summer Intern Program of Preston Hollow Presbyterian Church has been designed to impact the lives of our interns and our youth as they create lasting relationships rooted in Christ and practice what it means to be leaders in the church. This endeavor supports our church mission to be a loving and welcoming congregation, a learning congregation, and a supporting congregation. The College Summer Intern Program will:

- Create an environment where college students serve in an active role to maintain the youth ministry program over the summer by building relationships with youth, helping with the planning and leading of youth summer trips, and organizing communications efforts.
- Develop leadership skills among college-aged students and create lifelong leaders in the church at large through trips, Bible studies, and fellowship with youth.
- Provide an opportunity to expand the scope of our college ministry opportunities.

Typical Summer Schedule:

The College Summer Intern will work a total of 10 weeks. They will begin work on June 1st, and will conclude on August 5th. Responsibilities include:

Programmatic Responsibilities:

- Assist in planning and leading all summer trips.
- Assist in planning and attending Wednesday summer activities.
- Lead 1-5 bible studies or trip devotionals throughout the summer.
- Assist with long-term fall planning and visioning.
- Other responsibilities as assigned by the Associate Pastor and Director for Youth Ministries (i.e., youth house cleaning or inventory, hospitality/outreach, serve as liturgist, etc.).
- Meet with 1-3 youth (one-on-one) per week.

Communication Responsibilities:

- Maintain and schedule posts for the Youth social media platform.
- Make slides and Canva images for instagram stories, newsletters and facebook

events

- Help design and write youth newsletters

Vocational Responsibilities:

- Read at least one book with the Associate Pastor for leadership or spiritual growth.
- Meet weekly with either Associate Pastor or Director for Youth Ministries.
- Must have successfully completed sophomore year of college, or age equivalent.
- Familiarity with youth ministry or church sector.
